

What is Supported Employment?

Supported employment is an effort to individualize supports and create maximum flexibility and creativity, in order that each person can achieve his or her vocational goals. Supports offered vary, but range from developing community employment and providing job coaching and periodic check-ins, to enclave settings where a number of individuals work in a community setting with a permanent job coach, to site-based work.
