INTENSIVE FOSTER CARE finds children homes with families who have been trained to address their specific needs.

EARLY INTERVENTION serves children, birth to 36 months, at home who have or are at risk of development delays.

EARLY INTERVENTION PARTNERSHIP serves pregnant women whose children are at risk of poor health outcomes and delays.

HEALTHY FAMILIES serves first-time parents age 21 or younger, until the child's third birthday.

CHAPTER 766 SCHOOL serves students 3 to 22 years of age with multiple disabilities.

FAMILY SUPPORT AND RESPITE SERVICES supports individuals living with their families in receiving tailored services.

TRANSITIONAL JOB SUPPORT assists adults in finding and maintaining meaningful paid employment.

INDIVIDUAL SUPPORT serves adults living on their own in the community by providing drop-in support for daily life management.

SHARED LIVING finds adults homes with families who have been trained to address their specific needs.

ADULT FAMILY CARE finds adults with medical needs homes with families who have been trained to address their specific needs.

SUPPORTED LIVING provides direct ongoing services and supports to adults with disabilities living independently in their own homes.

SUPERVISED LIVING provides 24/7 support to adults living in groups of two to four in neighborhood homes.

DAY HABILITATION provides high needs adults a comprehensive managed program of services in a supportive and caring environment.

Back Home to Stay

Major Home Renovations allow Joseph to Keep his Independence

Keeping people in their homes, whatever their definition may be, is one of our primary commitments to the people we serve. They deserve to have stability and security over the long term and this often means rising to overcome unexpected hurdles.

Joseph has lived in a KDC home for the past 20 years, and has formed strong friendships with his roommates and bonds with his house staff. Unfortunately, over the past few years Joseph's health has been declining and this past winter he suffered a broken hip after a fall in his home.

After nearly six months in a rehabilitation facility, Joseph was still having difficulty walking and left the facility using a walker and wheelchair. The staff, and Joseph himself, were determined that he would return home and not be relegated to a nursing home. Several options were discussed and dismissed. It was finally settled on that the best solution was to install a mini-elevator, or minivator, that could transport Joseph from the first floor garage entryway to the second floor.

Along with the installation of the minivator, bathroom modifications were completed. Joseph returned home in June to a party in his honor. Friends and staff welcomed Joseph as he arrived upstairs in style!

It was only due to the resolve of the staff and the ability of KDC to provide for these changes that Joseph was able to come back home where he belongs, to stay.

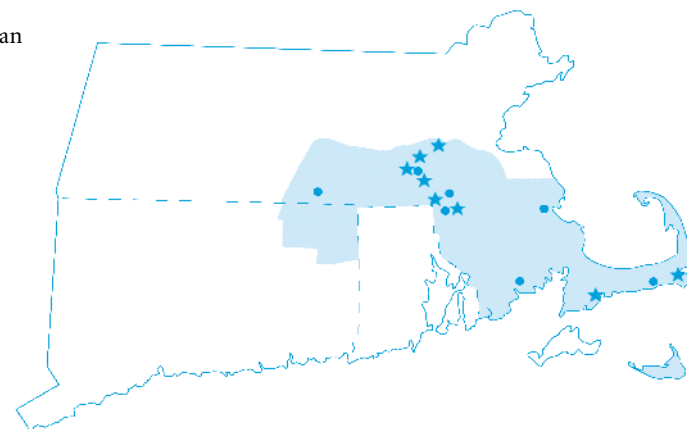

Over 230 people came together on May 14th in celebration of Kennedy-Donovan Center's 40th anniversary of providing services. Family members of our founder, Luella Hennessey Donovan, were in attendance and helped us welcome guests to the event. And what better way to celebrate than to pay tribute to this year's Founder's Award winners.

This year's honorees truly touched our hearts and inspired us with their stories. Doug and Sammi Robertson's lives were forever changed in 2001 when they discovered their son Bailey had autism. Over the past eight years, the Robertsons have met this challenge by immersing themselves in the cause, raising over \$400,000 for research, awareness, and support of people with autism and their families. They are tireless advocates for families and their leadership and commitment is extraordinary.

Gjia Silva is a remarkable woman. A young, single, mother-to-be, she was a participant in KDC's Healthy Families program until her son's third birthday in 2007.

Healthy Families serves first time parents under 21 with help in setting and reach goals, education relating to pregnancy and parenting, and identifying and accessing community resources.

While in the program, Gjia completed the Choices program at Massasoit Community College and completed the Nursing program there. She is now a licensed Register Nurse. She did this while contending with numerous challenges, including financial hardships and medical issues for herself and her son. Gjia

served as a role model for other young parents in the program and continues to be a source of inspiration for others.

New Grants to Kennedy-Donovan Center

KDC School and Facilities Upgrades in New Bedford and Attleboro

The Sean McDonough Foundation granted \$8,000 to Kennedy-Donovan Center's School in New Bedford to provide the continuation of experiential learning at Wellspring Farm in Rochester. CVS Caremark Charitable Trust gave KDC School grants of \$2,500 and \$11,000 respectively for school supplies and for new laptops and classroom computers for our teachers and students as part of our ongoing technology plan.

Grant money is still coming in for the roof replacement project in New Bedford. The City of New Bedford committed to a \$40,000 Community Development Block Grant;

Agnes Lindsay Trust granted \$2,500; and the Patrick Carney Foundation gave \$1,000 towards the roof replacement project.

Bristol County Savings Foundation granted \$7,500 toward repair of our Attleboro Early Intervention facility which is an ongoing project to repair the roof and replace or repair all of the HVAC systems on that building.

We are extremely grateful for the collaborations with all of our grantors. Their support and partnerships allow us to provide quality programs and services to the children and adults who receive our support.

Kevin Rodman Conare Appointed to DDS Self-Determination Advisory Committee

Kevin Rodman Conare, President and CEO of KDC, was appointed by Commissioner Elin M. Howe to serve on the Department of Developmental Services (DDS, formerly DMR) Self-Determination Advisory Committee. Last fall, the Governor passed legislation directing DDS to convene an advisory committee to assist the department in developing recommendations for implementing a self-determination model for funding services and supports of those served by the department.

"It's a great honor to work with the insightful and dedicated members of this committee. We were also glad to be on the ground floor in modeling programs that create more self-directed options for people. This will ultimately help KDC in our own program planning," commented Kevin Rodman Conare.

Families Affected by State Budget Cuts

Many services in Massachusetts were affected by the State's budget cuts. Included in these cuts were over \$40 million in services for Developmental Disabilities. 4,500 families receiving Families Support Services will no longer receive these needed services due to the budget cuts. That's almost half of the total 10,000 families who received services last year in the state. KDC served 10% (or 1,000) of those families.

Families getting these services from KDC were directly impacted. Over \$1.4 million was eliminated from KDC contracts, cutting services to over 500 families. This has come as a devastating blow for many families who are already feeling the effects of the recession.

KDC was fortunate to be able to move some employees in the Family Support Programs to open positions in other programs. However we were still forced to layoff six dedicated staff who will be sorely missed by the families and by their colleagues.

In the meantime, KDC continues to advocate with sister organizations, Association of Developmental Disabilities Providers (www.addp.org) and The Massachusetts Council of Human Service Providers (www.providers.org) to restore funding to families. Please consider advocating on behalf of the 4,500 families who will lose services by visiting the ADDP website and contacting your local legislators.

We continue to fundraise to help make up for some of the budget cuts through vehicles such as the Rodman Ride for Kids (www.rodmanrideforkids.org) and other fundraising channels.

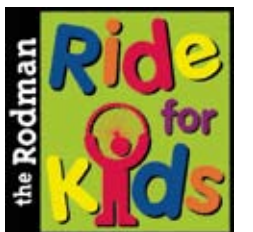
