DAY HABILITATION •



- Day program for adults facing developmental disabilities
- Qualified & experienced team facilitates skill-building & community integration with 1:4 ratio in classrooms
- Nursing services for complex medical needs



Ages 16+

- KDC case management of medications, health & home environment
